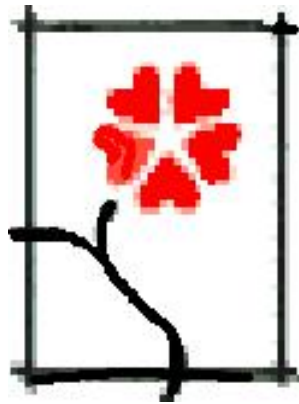

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1. Introduction:

Westbank College of Nursing (Unit of Asia Heart Foundation) was established in 2020 and offers B. Sc Nursing with the objectives to prepare clinical Nurse, Nurse administrators & Nurse educators to shoulder responsible positions & facilitate better education with added trust to short term courses in specialties of nursing.

The College of Nursing is affiliated by Indian Nursing Council (INC), West Bengal Nursing Council (WBNC) & West Bengal University of Health Sciences.

Our institution is having excellent parent hospitals, named **Narayana Multispeciality Hospital** and **Narayana Superspeciality Hospital** under the aegis of **Narayana Health**. at Howrah. Our college is being run by Asia Heart Foundation, a Trust, governed by **Dr. Devi Prasad Shetty**, eminent Cardiac Surgeon of our Country, who founded Narayana Health. Narayana Health has 47 healthcare facilities (21 owned hospitals in India, 6 heart centers, 19 primary care facilities and 1 hospital at Cayman Islands) with 5859 Operational Beds in India. We have 3 JCI & 7 NABH accredited hospitals.

3. Admission Criteria

For B. Sc. Nursing

1. The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on 31st December of the year in which admission is sought.
2. *Minimum Educational Qualification: Higher Secondary with Science including Biology*
 - a. A candidate has to pass in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology (PCB) and English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 45% marks taken together in PCB at the qualifying examination (10+2).
 - b. Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government having science subjects and English only.
 - c. English is a compulsory subject in 10+2.
3. Candidate should be medically fit. Colour Blind candidates may be considered for admission to Nursing Courses subject to the condition that Colour corrective contact lens and spectacles are worn by such candidates.
4. Candidate shall be admitted once in a year.
5. All relevant Certificates are to be produced in Original with attested Xerox copies at the time of counseling.

4. Admission process

- B.Sc. Nursing-Through written competitive examination conducted by JENPAUH Qualified → Online Counseling → Admission to the allotted institution with requisite fees.

- ❖ All boarders must abide the rules and regulations of the institution.
- ❖ In case of any damage caused by any student either in hostel or in Institution, damage Cost + penalty will be charged.
- ❖ Payment of course & hostel fees must be paid by student at the beginning of each session.
- ❖ **Other Expenses-** Student must payseparately for:
 - Expenses for Practical Field. (Outside the parent hospital)
 - Expenses for research work (outside the parent hospital)
 - Expenses for outer state experience.
 - Expenses for Educational tour.
 - Expenses for University/WBNC fees (examination, registration, dissertation etc.)
 - Expenses for Uniform. Books and other co-curricular activities

- In case of failure of payment of requisite fees by the prescribed date, late fees @10% per month on the due amount will be claimed.

6. Fees Rules

- No fees will be refundable, once paid.

NOTE: In case of extension of course due to supplementary examination the requisite course & hostel fees must be borne by the candidate.

7. Cancellation of admission

The Institute shall have the right to cancel admission and / or studentship of any student during the session if she is found guilty of any of the following charges:

1. Suppression of information.
2. Supply of false documentations.
3. Medically unfit.
4. Discrepancy of the marks in mark sheet after verification by the concerned Board
5. Violation of any Rules & regulations

08. Rules & Regulation

• GENERAL

1. All students are required to be punctual and are not allowed to skip classes without genuine reason and without prior permission from the Class Teacher and Principal of College.
2. Students must be in recommended uniform in the clinics, community and in the classroom.
3. No visitors, mobile phones are allowed during class as well as during duty hours
4. Each student is responsible to pay all the examination fees and fees for special clinical exposure as per curriculum.
5. B.Sc Nursing students must have their own Bank Account Number along with Debit Card for the Online Student Registration under West Bengal University of Health Sciences.
6. Be punctual in submitting your assignments to the respected teachers.

• HOSTEL

1. Students are not allowed to keep any valuables like jewellery in the hostel. Students are solely responsible for their personal belongings.
2. Hostel articles must be returned at the time of leaving the hostel. Clearance will be given only after that.
3. Rooms and beds shall be allocated by the Hostel-In-charge and no personal preference will be entertained.
4. Overall cleanliness of the room is to be maintained by the students residing in the hostel.
5. Pasting Stickers & writing on the walls and furniture are not allowed. As and when it is found the caution money will be deducted for repairing the walls and furniture.
6. No furniture to be moved from the room.
7. Students are not permitted to use any electrical appliance other than light & fan, which are provided from the hostel and mobile phone.
8. Use of Candle / Agarbati or any other source of fire is strictly prohibited.
9. Fans & lights to be switched off before leaving the rooms.
10. No visitors are allowed in student's rooms.
11. **Visiting hours:** - Visitors are allowed to meet their wards only on Sunday & holidays from 10 am to 5 pm.
12. Students can go outside from 8 AM to 6 PM after documentation (signature) in the outgoing register in the hostel. (Only Sunday)
13. Students are allowed to take 2 out passes & 2 night passes in each month. Out Pass only on Sundays and for night pass, after finishing the classes on Saturday with prior information.

- 14. Student should maintain the meal off register for not taking hostel meal on the day of day pass or any other Day.**
- 15.** Disciplinary action will be taken in case any student leaves the hostel without proper documentation.
- 16.** No students are allowed to come out from their room in indecent dress.
- 17.** Smoking, alcohol, Gutka, other substances are strictly prohibited.
- 18.** Strict action will be taken against the students if rules are violated.
- 19.** Serious Disciplinary action will be taken against the student found absent from the hostel without any information.

- **SICKNESS RULES**

1. If any student falling sick at hostel, sickness must be reported and recorded to the warden by the sick student/roommate.
2. No students are allowed to stay at room without reporting sickness to the Warden.
3. Warden will seek medical assistance, if required.
4. Self-medication is strictly prohibited.
5. In case of any major illness/hospitalization, information will be sent & guardian must attend as soon as possible.
6. If any student falling sick in the college, clinical field, sickness must be reported to the respective teacher.
7. If any student falling sick at home, sickness must be reported to the concerned teacher and field. She should produce treatment card/ prescription and guardian letter, when she will join the college.
8. Absenteeism due to sickness for 3 or more days need to produce medical fit certificate to resume normal duty.

- **LEAVE & ABSENTISM RULES**

1. Students must adhere to the leave provided by institution.
2. Any special leave may be granted as a Special case by the Competent Authority but the student must make good the duty hours.
3. Students are strongly discouraged to do unauthorized absenteeism.
4. In case of unauthorized leave or absenteeism, the students must report to the co - coordinator and warden (in case of hostel living) before resuming daily activities.
5. After absenteeism, no students are allowed to do daily activities without reporting to the coordinator.

- **LIBRARY RULES**

1. Students of B.Sc.(N) will issue two books per 7 days. If the student failed to return within the stipulated time, late fine Rs.10/- per day will be charged.
2. Books cannot be taken out of the library without proper issuance
3. Any tempering of the books must be notified to the librarian immediately at the time of issue of the books.
4. For any damage found at the time of returning of an issued document, the borrower has to pay a cost for the repair of the same.
5. In case of loss of books by any student they have to replace the same book of latest edition.

09. Information to the guardians

1. Guardians are not allowed to make any phone calls/meeting with their wards during class and clinical duty.
2. In case of any emergency, guardian need to contact the coordinator.
3. If any guardians want to meet the principal, seek appointment through your ward.
4. Without prior appointment, no guardian will be allowed to meet with Principal except emergency.
5. Guardian must attend the schedule of Parent Teacher meeting.

10. Anti-ragging Policy

RAGGING IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED

1. We have anti-ragging policy based on UGC & INC guidelines to address the ragging issues immediately through the following committee
 - Anti ragging committee (Consisting of Head of the institutions, representative of civil & police administration, NGOs involved in youth activities, representatives of faculty members, representatives of parents, representatives of students, non teaching staff and chaired by Head of the institution)
Quorum shall be formed with the attendance of majority of the members.
 - Monitoring cell (upper level & lower level) comprising of 10 students and 2 teachers.
 - Anti ragging Squad comprising of 10 members. Committee comprising of representatives of faculty members, warden, office staff and coordinated by a teacher selected by principal.
2. If any student experiences any ragging issue, first report of the incident shall be done by the student to the Monitoring Cell at lower level followed by upper level.
3. Every student who takes admission to this institution has to give undertaking in the form of affidavit for making ragging-free campus.
4. Frequent / Periodical supervision & raid in hostel & class room shall be done by the above Committees.

Punishment:

- Suspension from attending classes & Academic privileges
- Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process
- Cancellation of admission
- Collective punishment
- Suspension/expulsion from the hostel
- Fine of Rs.25,000/- to 1lakh.

11. Grievance Redressal Policy

- We have Grievance Redressal Mechanism based on UGC guidelines to address any grievance of students on immediate basis. We always believe in one-to-one contact with all students and ensure utmost safety and security whatsoever.
- If any student needs any of the grievance to be redressed, the respective student must immediately report to the Students' Grievances Redressal Committee either through the dedicated Portal or get in touch with the Committee.
